GENERAL FILING INFORMATION

DEADLINE TO FILE your 2021 Roseville Income Tax Return without penalty, interest or late fee is 4:00 P.M. on April 18, 2022. Returns received by the tax office after this date or postmarked by the Postal Service after this date will be considered late and will be subject to penalty, interest and late fee.

EXTENSION REQUESTS: If you wish to apply for an extension to file your return, a copy of your Federal Extension must be filed with the Roseville Income Tax Office no later than 4:00 P.M. on April 18, 2022. A Federal Extension does not automatically extend your Roseville tax return. Payment of tax owed for 2021 and the filing of the 2022 Declaration of Estimated Tax with the first quarter payment are still due by April 18, 2022.

TAX PREPARATION: The Roseville Income Tax Office provides free preparation of your Roseville Income Tax Return on a first-come, first-serve basis, Tuesday through Friday, 8:00AM to 4:00PM.

SCHOOL DISTRICT TAX: N/A

REMITTANCE: Make check or money order payable to *Roseville Income Tax*. Balances less than \$10.00 need not be paid, but the return must still be filed by April 18, 2022. Payments must be received or postmarked by April 18, 2022 to avoid penalty, interest and late fees.

STUDENT FILING REQUIREMENTS: If you turned 18 years of age during 2021 and your legal domicile (residency) is in Roseville, you are required to file an annual tax return even if no tax is due. College students maintaining Roseville as their legal domicile (residency) are subject to all Roseville Tax regulations. If you used an address inside the corporation limits of Roseville to file your Federal and State tax returns, you are considered a resident of Roseville.

MANDATORY REGISTRATION AND FILING: Roseville residents, age 18 and older, are required to register with the Tax Office to establish a tax account within 30 days of residency or turning age 18. Residents must file an annual Roseville tax return, even if no tax is due, unless an exemption is filed. Partial year residents are required to file a return on the portion of income earned while a resident of Roseville.

JOINT FILING: A husband and wife may elect to file joint tax returns regardless of how the Federal or State Tax Return is filed.

NON-RESIDENTS: A non-resident does not have to file a tax return and report taxable income to Roseville if the tax was fully withheld by the employer. Non-residents file and report business activity income including rental income even if a net loss is realized.

LINE BY LINE INSTRUCTIONS: Verify that your name and address are correct on the tax form. Fill in your social security number(s) and phone number. If you were a partial year resident, fill in the date you moved in or out of Roseville and provide your previous address.

LINE 1 Enter the total qualifying wages (usually W2 box 5 Medicare wages and tips-highest amount on W2). Contributions to deferred compensation plans (such as 401(k) are taxable. See ORC 718.03

LINE 2 If applicable, enter miscellaneous income such as tips not included in wages and 1099 income not included on your Federal Schedule.

LINE 3 If applicable, enter business income reported on Federal Schedule C or rental income reported on Federal Schedule E. Losses must be entered as zero. Attach copies of Federal Schedules to tax return.

LINE 4 Enter items not taxable

LINE 5 Add lines 1,2,and 3

LINE 6 Multiply line 5 by 1% (0.01).

LINE 7 Enter the amount of Roseville tax withheld as shown on your W2s in box 19 . DO NOT include School District Tax withheld.

LINE 8 Enter declaration tax payments paid for 2021 using exact dollars and cents paid. Contact Tax Office for total if you are unsure.

LINE 9 Enter prior year credit carryover that was not refunded or applied to prior year debt, using exact dollars and cents.

LINE 10 Add lines 7, 8 and 9.

LINE 11 If line 6 is greater than 10, subtract line 10 from line 6.
If line 10 is greater than 6, subtract line 6 from line 10.

LINE 12 Calculate penalty, interest and late fee as follows:

A. PENALTY: Calculated by Income Tax Administrator.

B. INTEREST: (fraction of a month counts as whole month)

C. LATE FEE: 30 days or less = \$25.00 (ADD \$25.00 PER MONTH UP TO \$150.00)

D. Add lines 12A, 12B and 12C.

LINE 13 Add lines 11 and 12D.

LINE 13A Overpayment of \$10.00 or less will not be refunded or carried forward. Indicate distribution of overpayment. Overpayment will first be applied to outstanding prior balance before being refunded or carried forward.

LINE 14 Estimate the amount you expect to appear on Line 6 of the 2022 Roseville Return. Without an acceptable explanation, this amount must be at least 90% of Roseville's Taxable Income for 2021.

LINE 15 Estimate the amount of your liability you expect to be met through withholding.

LINE 16 Line 14 minus Line 15. If this amount is less than \$200.00, no quarterly payments are required and you do not need to complete Lines 17, 18 and 19; Enter 0.

LINE 17 Line 16 divided by 4

LINE 18 The amount (if any) from Line 13A

LINE 19 Line 17 minus Line 18. If Line 17 exceeds Line 18, payment must be with the filing of the declaration. If Line 18 exceeds Line 17, no payment is required at this time, Enter 0.

LINE 20 Line 13 plus Line 19
