General Information

- Council approved Big Dog Refuse to be the first Village of Roseville's single trash hauler for residential customers on December 29, 2020 as they were the lowest and best bid. Council made this decision after nearly 1 year of discussions and research. This was the second attempt to pass a single trash hauler in the past 15 years. This decision was made in order to prolong the useful life of the Village's one-million-dollar road resurfacing project that was completed in October of 2020 and the \$400,000 storm drain project to be completed in 2021.
- This is curbside TRASH and RECYLING service for all residents with an option for businesses to participate. This service will begin April 2, 2021. Each resident will receive a 95-gallon trash container by April 1st and a 35-gallon recycling container on wheels in July-August 2021.
- Big Dog Refuse will be doing quarterly billing for your trash service. A senior discount will be given for those who complete the registration card that verifies you are 65 years of age and head of household at the beginning of the quarterly billing cycle. A simple registration process was set up by the Village.
- The Village notified trash haulers that Roseville is now a single trash hauling community effective April 1, 2021. There will be information put in the newspaper, on social media, and email notifications again in February and March 2021. It would still be appropriate to let your hauler know. If you paid for an entire year (2021) you may start seeking a refund for quarters 2, 3, and 4. If anyone is having difficulties getting reimbursement from their trash hauler contact Heidi Milner and she will help you. However, you must first show proof of an email or letter seeking reimbursement on your own. The Village will draft a sample letter that you can use.
- There is no opt out option for residents. This was discussed during the public meeting but was never approved. This option was up to Village Council. The haulers would not give competitive rates if they don't know how many people will opt out. The opt out option not only eliminates the savings to residents but also eliminates the goal of reducing large vehicles on Village roads, curbs, and storm drains deeming the entire process a waste of time and money. In no documents that were approved by Village Council in the past year was there an opt out option for this round. Council approved the advertisement for bid, bid documents, and now the notice of award. The opt out option was 10 years ago which led to non-competitive rates and no contract.

Refuse Collector:

The Village of Roseville Mayor and Council held discussions for a year to transition from an open trash collection service to a single trash collector. This decision was difficult but necessary in order to add years to the useful life of the recent 5.5 million dollars in infrastructure projects. The Village solicited bids for trash and recycling in both the Perry County Tribune and the Zanesville Times Recorder beginning November 18, 2020. The solicitation was also published on the Village of Roseville's Facebook and Webpage on November 13, 2020.

On December 29, 2020, the Roseville Village council passed legislation to award a contract to the lowest and best bidder, Big Dog Refuse, as the Village's single trash and recycling collection hauler. The Village of Roseville will become a single trash hauler for all residents inside the corporation of Roseville on April 1, 2021. Commercial properties are not required to change their contract.

Please prepare to remove all your residential services by March 30, 2021. Residents do not have an option to opt out and must comply with this contract. It is our understanding some residents paid for services for the entire year (2021). Therefore, you may receive requests seeking reimbursement for fees that they paid you in advance. Due to the services not being rendered we request that you refund your Roseville customers the unused portion. If you have any questions on a specific address, please do not hesitate to contact our office to verify that the address is part of this transition.

- Every resident will be required to have trash and recycling service provided by the contracted trash hauler. Failure to pay will result in placing a lien on the resident's property taxes. This will ensure that trash still gets collected even though a resident fails to pay the charges thus keeping trash off the streets.
- Big Dog Refuse will begin delivering TRASH totes in March 2021. Your first TRASH pick up will be Friday, April 2, 2021. Then will be picked up every Friday thereafter between 7am-7pm.
- Recycling will be phased in during the second quarter. This is to help both the residents, businesses, and contractors get a rhythm before both trash and recycling are enforced. Residents will begin receiving 35-gallon recycling totes in August 2021.

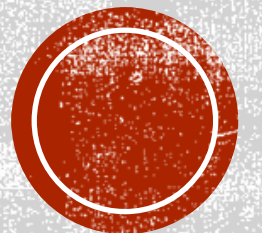

TRASH AND RECYCLING SERVICE

- This is an unlimited trash service, within reason (no moving, multiple families, etc.). If there are multiple families living in the same house, garage, building you can add another service to the same address by calling the contractor.
 - Trash/Recycling must be placed curbside the night before your scheduled collection. Drivers may not return to residences if materials are unprepared at the scheduled collection time.
 - Trash must be bagged in no larger than 32-gallon bags and shall not exceed 50lbs.
 - Recycling should NOT be bagged. Rinse and dump loose in clearly marked recycling tote provided. Recycling must be free of food and true waste. If there is trash in the recycling tote the entire tote must be discarded.
 - One large item per month for disposal is permitted. Call 48 hours in advance for large items or excessive amounts of trash. All items must comply with State and Local laws for disposal.
 - Television sets cannot exceed 32 inches for curbside pick-up.
 - Any mattress or upholstered furniture must be completely sealed in disposable plastic for removal. Additional fees may apply for more than 1 large item per month.
 - Freon containing appliances require special handling. Contact Big Dog Refuse for more details on proper disposal rules.
- **PLEASE DO NOT:**
 - Place trash at the curb in boxes. All boxes should be broken down and bundled. Contractor is not responsible for damaged or missing plastic cans or lids.
 - According to Federal law, the contractor is not permitted to accept batteries, tires, liquids, combustible materials or any items identified as hazardous.
 - Bulky materials including drywall, concrete, bricks, dirt or rocks are not acceptable.
 - Drums, barrels, yard and household containers are not acceptable trash containers and will be assumed trash if placed at the curb.

TRASH AND RECYCLING TOTE TIPS

TOTES ARE TO BE TAKEN TO THE ROADWAY ON THURSDAY NIGHT AND RETRIEVED FRIDAY NIGHT. NEVER LEAVE YOUR TOTES BY THE ROADWAY AFTER TRASH SERVICE.

▪ Damaged or Stolen Totes:

- Totes that are stolen or damaged due to neglect by the customer will be the responsibility of the consumer at their cost. Protect yourself by only placing your trash/recycling out the night before and retrieving your totes by the end of the day on Friday.
- Totes that are stolen, damaged, or vandalized within the 24 hours of waste collection service (Thursday Night-Friday Night) may be replaced by the contractor. First contact the police to make a report of the damaged tote, stolen tote, etc. Obtain a copy of the police report and attach it to the contractor's complaint form. A copy of the police report will need submitted along with the form and sent to the contractor.

▪ Costs

- Replacement Trash or Recycling Tote Cost: \$60
- Extra Trash Totes are available for a fee of \$4 per month or \$12 per quarter.
- One Extra Recycling Tote will be available at no charge for those consistently utilizing their current tote to the fullest. Recycling Service begins in August 2021.

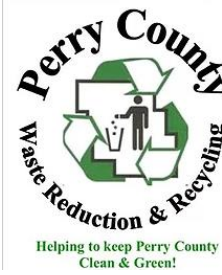

RECYCLING SERVICE

■ What we accept:



Glass: -Clear & Brown beverage bottles

**Remove all plastic/metal lids and rings.*

Plastics:

- -Milk jugs, pop bottles & other containers with #1 or #2 in recycling triangle near the bottom of container

**Remove all plastic/metal lids and rings.*

Aluminum Cans:

- -Flattening saves space...

Steel Food Cans:

- -All "tin" and steel food cans are accepted

**Again, flattening saves space!*

Newspapers, Magazines, Office Paper and Catalogs:

- -Newspapers may be bagged or thrown in loose.
- -Slick, glossy magazines and catalogs are also accepted. Bag glossy separately from non-glossy papers

Corrugated Cardboard and Pasteboard:

- -All corrugated boxes. Please flatten boxes to save space!
- Includes cereal boxes, pop boxes and other thin pasteboard materials.

■ What we don't accept

and why we don't...

Light bulbs, Window Glass:

- All glass is not created equal! The glass in these items is not something you want mixed into new glass bottles!

#3-#7 Plastics, Plastic Toys, etc....

- No Plastics that are #3,4,5,6,7. Only plastic containers with # 1 or #2 on them are recyclable!
- Just as brown glass is different from clear glass, a # 5 plastic tub is not the same as a #1 pop bottle... Different types of plastics cannot successfully be merged into a usable product...
- Contamination costs the recycling facility time to sort and can cost them by lowering the price they receive for their finished product.

PAINT:

- Buy what you need, use what you buy, donate what is left! As a last resort, dry it up until completely hard and dispose with trash (leave lids off so trash hauler knows it is not liquid!)

Motor Oil:

- Is accepted at Perry Counties Ultimate Recycling Days. Dates vary, but we try to organize two in the spring and two in the fall. Call Perry County's Recycling office for other options that may be available.
- Hazardous household chemicals can be taken to Environmental Enterprises Inc. in Columbus. Call Perry County Recycling's office for more information 740-342-7881.

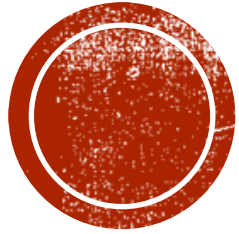
